Luther’s 95th Thesis:

“And let them thus be more confident of entering heaven through many tribulations...”

Martin Luther quoted this text in the final thesis of his 95 Theses. The posting of the 95 Theses on October 31, 1517, started the great Reformation of the church. This quote from Luther emphasized that God’s people, in taking up their cross and following Christ, will endure suffering on this earth. This knowledge brings us comfort in our sufferings, as we look to our head Jesus Christ, who also suffered.
